3. Prep Implant Driver Mount as provisional abutment
4. Immediate provisionalization of #9 with fixed crown.
5. #28 – Atlantis abutments and provisional, seat abutment, .5 mm supragingival, write Rx to drop margin 1.5 mm, seat final abutment and crown
6. #18 & #19, non-parallel, use Atlantis abutments and try-in framework
